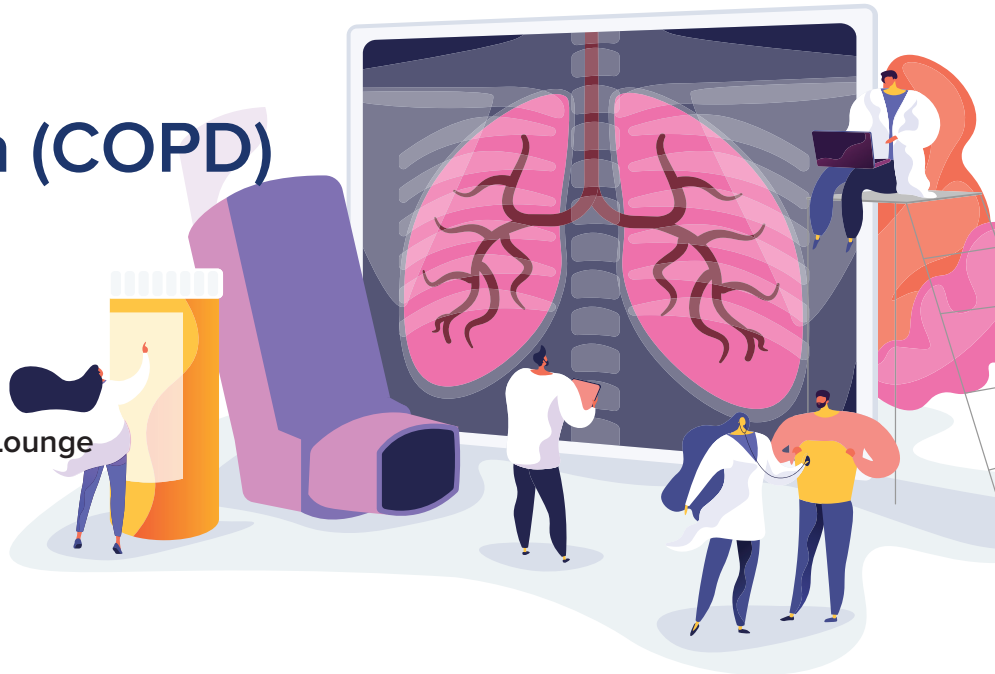

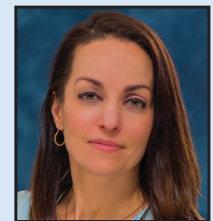
Emphysema, including chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), is a progressive, inflammatory lung disease that makes breathing difficult. Symptoms include shortness of breath, chest tightness, wheezing and a recurrent cough that produces large amounts of mucus.

This presentation will include discussion of a new treatment option, called bronchoscopic lung volume reduction (BLVR), which places tiny endobronchial valves in the lungs. The minimally invasive procedure helps people with severe emphysema, including COPD, breathe easier. Inova Fairfax Hospital is one of the most experienced centers now offering BLVR.
